From the Office: As many of you had seen in last Week's bulletin, we now have a new way of reporting our weekly offerings.

The table reflects the week of **fiscal year we** are in, what we are budgeted weekly, what we bring in that particular week and what our total donations are at that point. In Last week's bulletin, the deficit was also included in the table. The deficit number is calculated based on the actual end of year total we had brought in on Sunday Collections. Last fiscal year, which ended on June 30th, our total number of Sunday collections was \$213,408. This number is then divided by 52 weeks, which gives us the budgeted weekly offering. When all the numbers are filled in on the table, the Sunday offering to date then gets subtracted from the \$213,408.00, which is why the deficit goes down each week. This is the number we are working towards. However, it has been decided that the deficit will no longer be included in the table. We have included the number of envelopes collected each week out of what we mail out. We hope that this gives you a better explanation of the table.
